The playing surface is a close pile green felt carpet glued to a concrete floor with hoop holes drilled into with sleeves to receive the hoops. The full-size standard hoops have nylon feet (replacing carrot) which slide into the holes and can be removed when the room is required for other purposes and small covers placed over holes.


The overall dimensions 9m x 7m

The lawn is used primarily in winter months and mainly GC is played with slightly adapted rules regarding 'boundaries' and offside etc. At busy sessions games are limited to 20 minutes or first to 5 hoops.
